Hassina Khan

Winner, Glass Society Prize 2023 Hassina Khan completed her MA in Glass at the University of Sunderland in 2022 and returned to work with us in 2023, taking part in a residency kindly funded by the Glass Society. Hassina uses glass to express English words written in Urdu text, mimicking her experience as a bi-racial, English – Pakistani person. Introducing... Fused Glass

Stained Glass Leaded Technique - Beginner's level

National Glass Centre 24 September or 22 October / 10.00 – 14.00 / £50 Artist: Gill McGinley Suitable for ages 16+

An introduction to basic stained glass techniques.

7th Century saint Benedict Biscop brought artisans from Europe to create Monkwearmouth-Jarrow Priory. They made the first stained glass window in England and installed it in St Peters Church, a stone's throw from the National Glass Centre.

Stained Glass & Copper Foil

Suitable for ages 16+

Learn how to make your own stained glass and copper foil hanging ornaments. You will be taught precise glass cutting techniques, preparing the edges and how to use copper foil to create your piece. Sandblasting and engraving are optional should you want to vary the opacity of your glass creation and add mark making. We will be using solder alongside soldering irons and adding a copper wire loop to allow you to hang your ornaments at home.

This introductory day course in ceramics is suitable for anyone with no or little experience. Students will learn a range of throwing techniques from practical demonstrations. A chance to learn basic wheel based ceramic skills and practice throughout the day. Make a tea bowl or ornamental vessel.

Flameworked Marbles

In this one day class, you will make a number of marbles starting off with clear and moving on through the day to produce marbles with coloured patternation on the outside, mixed coloured twists on the inside and trapping bubbles inside the glass. By the end of the class, you will have made your very own hand made marbles.

Marbles you make have to be annealed overnight, so you will have to come back to pick up your work, If you are unable to pick up your work please inform when booking and we can arrange postage of your items at cost.

Flameworked Beads

In this half-day class, you will use soft glass-coloured rods and focus on forming circular beads by pulling glass stringers and using these to apply patternation to the surface of the bead. Using smooth and textural designs, let your imagination take over and create your very own designer bead.
