Barnes Park is an ideal space to host a variety of events.

Barnes Park is a large urban park with walks, play areas, bowling greens, sensory gardens, tennis courts and a cafe. The largest of the city's urban parks stretching just under 2 miles in length features a Victorian style bandstand and a cannon situated near to the West End bowling greens which was dredged from the River Wear.

A Victorian era public space which stretches over a swathe of the city's Southwest, technically spanning from Thorney Close all the way towards Pallion.
